MIRACLES FOR KIDS HELPS CRITICALLY-ILL CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES PREPARE FOR A NEW SCHOOL YEAR

OC-Based Nonprofit to Assemble and Deliver Backpacks Filled with School Supplies and PPE to Families in Need as they Prepare for a New School Year in the Midst of COVID-19 Pandemic

What:

Miracles for Kids helps families with critically-ill children battle bankruptcy, homelessness, hunger and depression – so they can concentrate on fighting for their child's life. In response to the pandemic, the organization has been focused on preventing these extremely vulnerable families from crumbling under the combined impact of their child's life-threatening illness, a devastated economy, and the effects of COVID-19 on their child's already compromised immune system.

As families prepare for an uncertain 2020-2021 school year, whether it be in person or virtual, Miracles for Kids' annual Back-to-School Basket of Miracles Program, which kicks off with setup and assembly on Monday, July 13th and ends with deliveries on Monday, July 20th, will deliver brand new backpacks filled with age-appropriate school supplies and packages of PPE, new shoes and other essentials to 300+ families with a critically-ill child throughout Southern California and the Bay Area.

Miracles for Kids' families live, on average, 15.5% (or \$4,300+) below the Federal Poverty Guideline¹. The items provided through the Back-to-School Basket of Miracles Program will stretch their already scarce budgets and ensure they have what they need for educational success – regardless if the children are learning in the classroom or at home.

The logistics to pull off the annual delivery program amidst the rising COVID-19 pandemic have been re-engineered to meet social distancing standards and safety guidelines to ensure the well-being of everyone involved. Over the course of a week, 100+ volunteers divided into small groups will sort, assemble, package and deliver the Back-to-School Basket of Miracles packages from outside stations setup throughout Miracles for Kids headquarters at Sky Park Circle in Irvine, CA.

Who:

Community volunteers, Miracles for Kids board members, donors and team members come together to serve our community's most vulnerable critically-ill children and families in desperate need.

Miracles for Kids is an Irvine-based nonprofit serving children with life-threatening illnesses and the families who care for them. They are one of the only organizations on the West Coast dedicated to alleviating the stressors that come with a critical illness, including bankruptcy, depression, hunger and homelessness.

Packages that are too far to drive, will be boxed up and shipped. A small number of patient families will

pick up their Back-to-School Basket of Miracles directly.
