In addition to paying bills and housing families at Miracle Manor - which is located less than a mile from CHOC - the organization provides crisis counseling, medical care and a variety of other supports to ensure that families have their basic needs met during the most emotionally excruciating time in their lives.

Responsibilities include managing logistics such as guest registrations, auction item procurement, sponsorship fulfillment, invoicing, and troubleshooting. The Events Manager will provide excellent customer service to our donors and represent Miracles for Kids in the community and on external event committees as needed.
