Bills, work, and the pressures of life don't stop when a child receives a devastating health diagnosis. Partnering with several major area companies, community organizations, and individuals, the **Miracles** team works tirelessly to ease the burden of families in crisis, so the caregivers can focus on caring for their sick child. The "**Spring Basket of Miracles**" program is just one way the nonprofit helps to provide for these families, delivering household and hygiene items - plus some seasonal goodies for the children.

Here are three ways to join in on the fun and help make a real impact this season:

- DONATE. The team is collecting seasonal items (pre-filled plastic eggs with individually wrapped candy, egg painting/dyeing kits, family card games, puzzles), household supplies (safe cleaning products like ECOS or Seventh Generation, kitchen towels, cleaning gloves or rags, Febreeze, Ziploc bags), and hygiene items (loofahs, bar soap, toothpaste, Kleenex/tissue). Send or drop off items during office hours (M-Th 8:30am-4:30pm and Fri 8:30am-1:30pm) by Friday, March 24th.
- 2. VOLUNTEER. Gather friends or colleagues and help assemble baskets at the Miracles for Kids offices on Saturday, April 1st from 9-11:30 AM.
- 3. **DELIVER BASKETS.** Bring joy to **Miracles** families directly by delivering baskets to families in the greater OC area on Saturday, **April 1st beginning at 12 PM.**
